Treasure Tip!

Look for male and female cones and kauri seeds on the ground.



Kawakawa is a small common tree with lots of uses for Maori.

Use by Maori

Leaves were used as bandages, and boiled for stomach aches and for tooth ache.



NIKAU

REWAREWA

Nikau is the only palm in New Zealand and is the most southern palm in the world.



Use by Maori

Maori used the leaves for house building and the centre of the tree is edible.

Did you find it? Rewarewa is a New Zealand honeysuckle which produces a very nice nectar for our native birds.

Did you know?

Rewarewa bark can be used to stop bleeding.




Did you find it?

TANEKAHA TĀTARAMOA

Tanekaha is a large and bendy tree. This tree is also known as Celery Pine.





Tātaramoa or bush lawyer is a vine.

Treasure Tip!

Take care when searching or Tātaramoa because the under side of the leaves have sharp hooks like thorns.
